

KNOWLEDGE CHECKPOINTS

To the Teacher: The following three knowledge checkpoints are designed to use along with the video tours of Levels II, VI, and VIII of Troy. You may want to give them to students before they see the videos, to encourage interest and discussion. Ask the same questions after the videos are viewed to check knowledge. Note that these are not thoroughgoing tests, but rather questions meant to stimulate interest and suggest some surprising facts about Troy.

Correct answers are as follows:

Troy II: 1-B, 2-D, 3-C, 4-B, 5-B

Troy VI: 1-D, 2-A, 3-B, 4-C, 5-B

Troy VIII: 1-C, 2-A, 3-C, 4-D, 5-C
